Active community volunteers with 45+ years of dedication to agricultural organizations, including 4-H, the Norwood Fair and the Peterborough County Soil & Crop Association; have hosted numerous farm events, demonstration days, bus tours and the County Plowing Match; operated Buckhaven Holsteins for 35 years with their four daughters; 2016 Peterborough County Farm Family of the Year.

Cynthia (Jibb) & John Crowley
Internationally known for their Crovalley Holstein genetics and for breeding 171 Excellent cows; recipients of two Holstein Canada Master Breeder Shields; hosts of County Twilight BBQs and countless farm events for students, elected officials and visitors from around the world; with their four children, they have been recognized as the 2003 Peterborough County Farm Family of the Year, and the 2017 Ontario Farm Family.

Wib Donaldson (1915-1996)
A renowned cattleman of Shorthorns and Herefords with a global reputation for advancing both breeds within the beef industry; traveled extensively, judging and promoting exports of breeding stock, semen, and embryos in Denmark, Hungary, Australia, South Africa, and Argentina; a Hereford Association Master Breeder and Honour Roll recipient; inductee of the Canadian Agricultural Wall of Fame.
